## REGISTER OF MEMBERS INTERESTS

<p>1. Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation: Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit or gain.</p> <p><b>Example: The name and address of your employer and the role in that company.</b></p>	<p>Trevor Bolton Engineering Services Limited          George Street West          Blackburn          Lancashire          BB2 1PQ</p>
<p>2. <b>Sponsorship:</b> Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the relevant authority) made or provided within the relevant period in respect of any expenses incurred by me in carrying out duties as a member, or towards the election expenses of me.</p>	
<p>3. <b>Contracts:</b> Any contract which is made between the relevant person (or a body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest) and the relevant authority –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and</li> <li>b. which has not been fully discharged.</li> </ul>	
<p>4. <b>Land:</b> Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the relevant authority.</p> <p><b>Example: Your home address (Do not leave the box empty)</b></p>	<p>53 Buckshaw Hall Close          Astley Village          Chorley          PR7 1SX</p>

<p>5. <b>Licences:</b> Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the relevant authority for a month or longer.</p>	
<p>6. <b>Corporate tenancies:</b> Any tenancy where (to my knowledge) -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. the landlord is the relevant authority; and</li> <li>b. the tenant is a body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest.</li> </ol>	
<p>7. <b>Securities:</b> Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where –</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. that body (to my knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the relevant authority; and</li> <li>b. either - <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I. the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or</li> <li>II. if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>	
<p>8. <b>Other Interests</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Organisations where you represent the Parish Council;</li> <li>• Other public authorities or organisations that deliver public services;</li> <li>• Companies, industrial and provident societies, charities or charitable organisations;</li> <li>• Trade Unions or professional associations.</li> </ul> <p><b><i>Example: A political Party membership. Membership of local group.</i></b></p>	<p>Councillor Astley &amp; Buckshaw Chorley Council GMB union member Labour Party member</p>

**9. Registering Gifts & Hospitality**

- Any gifts or hospitality worth over £25 which you receive in conjunctions with your official duties as a member, need to be declared.
- Gifts or hospitality not related to your role as a member. However, you should always consider whether any gifts or hospitality could be seen as connected to your role as a member.
- You may have to estimate how much a gift or hospitality is worth.
- You do not have to register gifts or hospitality if you do not accept them.
- Any gifts or hospitality must be registered within 28 days of receiving it.
- Your Clerk has a register relating to gifts and hospitality.
